1. Between 26 September and 14 October 1947, a total of 33,872 carloads of goods were handled by the Reichsbahn Direktion in Halle. The shipments consisted of

- a. 33,174 cars of fertilizers, fuel, chemicals, coal, cattle, food, and other goods
- b. 444 cars of reparations goods
- c. 162 cars of military equipment
- d. 92 cars of dismantled equipment

2. The most important items among the 33,174 cars listed under para. 1a were

Coal	28,228 carloads
Fertilizer	1,362 carloads
Chemicals	819 carloads
Various goods	906 carloads

The "various goods" included 86 carloads of scrap iron for Poland.

3. The break-down of the reparations shipments mentioned under para. 1b is the following:
