1. During the period 1 September to 25 September 1947, a total of 45,206 carloads of goods were handled by the Reichsbahn Direktion in Halle. Included in this total traffic were the following shipments:

- a. 531 cars of reparations goods.
- b. 603 cars of military equipment.
- c. 98 cars of dismantled equipment.
- d. 191 cars of scrap iron directed to Poland.
