

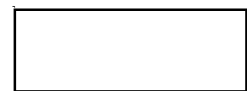

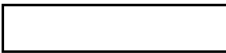

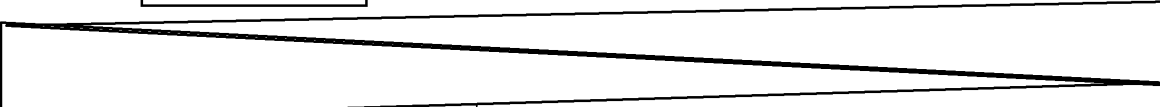

1. A vigorous propaganda campaign by the Communists against the United States and England was to be launched during the United Nations Conference on Employment and Trade which opened in Havana, Cuba, on 21 November 1947.
2. The Soviet Legation is making wide distribution of propaganda material to printing shops in Havana, Editorial Paginas, a well-known Communist propaganda center, being especially favored.
3. The Hungarian Bulletin, suspended a few months ago, was to resume publication beginning on or about 20 November 1947. Ilma Lukacs, a recent arrival from Europe, and mother of Paul Lukacs, a Yugoslav who is in close touch with the Russian Legation in Havana, is reported to have given orders to the editors of the Hungarian Bulletin for its immediate revival.
4. It has been observed that the Soviet Legation has been receiving increasingly large quantities of bulky packages by mail, especially from Argentina, Chile, and Brazil.
