1. Chinese Communist authorities in Manchuria have made a secret agreement with the USSR whereby the Soviets will be allowed to exploit for five years the forested area between the Suifen River (131-43) and Chiemussu (130-21, 46-49). The agreement also allows the Soviets to cut a stated number of railroad ties from the Ya Pu Lo Ni (重布洛尺) timber area along the Harbin-Suifen rail line.

The number of ties the Soviets will be allowed to cut is 25,000,000. In return the Soviets agreed to turn over to the Chinese Communist Northeast Railway Bureau all factories along the Chinese Changchun Railroad plus all supplies and equipment belonging to that railroad which were left behind by the Japanese..
