1. Between 3 - 5 November 1947, six trains heavily loaded with German machines for the production of war materials, especially lathes and boring machines for heavy and medium caliber rifles, passed through the Russian Zone of Austria under Russian military escort destined for Yugoslavia.
2. These trains had come from the Russian Zone of Germany and had travelled through Czechoslovakia.

( ) Comment: No comment can be made as to the reliability of the 5  
above information. However, it has been stated in previous reports that the  
Russians are intending to shift production, especially of armaments, out of  
the Russian Zone to satellite countries. ( )
