The tug "Marshal Rokossovski" which was launched at this yard is now at sea, and the lake tug "Kronshtadt" which was launched here is undergoing trials.

20. Svir Dockyard, located in the middle reaches of the Svir, between Podporozhie and the village Vazhin.

Hull, joinery, and plane shops, and a central warehouse have been erected. Two frames have been mounted in the main body of the sawmill, and there will be four soon. The installation of a "warm basin" ("tepli bassein") and of a sorting yard at the sawmill are completed. A fire station and garage have been built. When completed, this will be the country's largest wooden shipbuilding yard. A fleet of wooden barges totaling many thousands of tons will be launched from this yard.
