- It has been reported that Colonel Enrique Peralta Azurdia, Guatemelan Military Attache secredited to the Embassy in Chile and at present on leave in Guatemala Cliv, may seen be named Chief of Staff of the Guatemalan Army. The present Chief of Staff, Colonel Carlos Aldena Sandovel, is rumored to be slated for the catimet position of Minister of Communications and Public Works.

25X1A Comment: Poralis entered the Escuela Politécnica as a cadet in 1926. Upon graduation he studied in the Filltary School in Santiago, Chile. He was Sub-Director of the Escuela Politécnica from 1940 until early in 1944. He was Jefo Politico and Comardante de Armas in the Departmento de Totonicapañ in June. 1944. when he was approached by militarists, then preparing the coup detat culminating in the reseaseful revolution in October of that year who desired to postulate his condidacy as president of Guatemala. Colorel Peralta declined the offer, and upon the overthrow of the Fonce Government in October, 1944, was designated Military Attacho to Mexico, a post he held until January, 1945, when he was nered Military Attacks to Chile. He is now on official leave from this post, having arrived in Guatemain on 22 January from South America. Colonel Peralta visited the United States in 1940 as one of the Gustemulans designated by the Chiefs of Staff of Latin American countries at the conference inequalities at Wind thus by Jeneral Marshall.
