- On 7 May 1948, the electric power and cable unit, Truck [ ] was shipped to Berlin by rail. The truck was heavier than believed and tipped over en route, but no serious damage occurred; axles and wheels were taken off to facilitate further travel. As of 10 May, the truck was at the Friedrichshagen Bahnhof (V-04) awaiting shipment through Poland to [ ] Moscow. The stationary laboratory sent to Berlin by truck and trailer on 14 April was at the same station and was to be forwarded by rail with Truck [ ]. The equipment was inspected during the week of 3 May by Morkovkin, from Moscow, and Kopyrin and Azark of S. A Technical Bureau No. 11. [ ]

- When this equipment goes to Russia, it will be accompanied by Major Baurov, who has removed all his belongings from Sondershausen and is not expected to return there. The new Elektrobau technical director is Karl Röver, former labor chief.
- Trucks [ ] were to be delivered to Sondershausen by the Waggon Fabrik Gebrüder Schumann during the week of 10 May. Originally, the mobile laboratory was to consist of ten trucks; an eleventh has been added. Its purpose is not yet known.

- Elektrobau Sondershausen would be seriously hampered, [ ] if its supplies from other zones were cut off. Large quantities of expensive and unusual electrical equipment have been obtained through Berlin outlets [ ]
