1. Sergei Kalendjiev, a Bulgarian trade representative, offered to sell to various firms 10,000 tons of dried beans, 10,000 tons of lentils, and 50,000 tons of corn. He stated that he desired payment in dollars.
2. He is attempting to purchase mining equipment and spare parts for locomotives, as well as certain electrical parts for generators for the Granitoid Mining Company which is planning to expand the electrification of its works.
