SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1X

1. M. A. Borodin, a former industrialist in Harbin, has received orders through the Shanghai Soviet Consulate to be prepared to depart for Manchuria around the end of May or early June 1948. He will proceed to Moscow via Vladivostok for a short visit in order to receive instructions. He will be employed in the East Manchuria Railway Administration and will wear a special uniform.
2. Among the Soviet citizens in Shanghai who are also going to Manchuria are the following: Borodin's brother, a chemical engineer; I. I. Druri, Torgpredstvo employee; Rudakov, an engineer who is chairman of the Executive Committee of the Shanghai Soviet Citizens' Association. These people will probably be sent to Chabariivsk (sic) (? Khabarovsk?) to attend special courses before proceeding to Manchuria.
3. A number of Soviet citizens of Tientsin and Tsingtao who were formerly Russian emigres in Manchuria are now registered for service in Manchuria. All Soviet citizens in China who have assignments in Manchuria are expected to augment the USSR's Manchurian railway staff, which at present is at skeleton strength.
