SUPPLEMENT TO

- The gold mine at Lachinchang (127-18,42-53), which was reopened by the Chinese Communists in the summer of 1946, has greatly increased its output since April 1948. In June the mine employed 7,000 laborers, and the monthly output was 4,000 ounces monthly. This is the largest gold mine in Lanchuria.
- 2. The Chiapikou (127-25,42-50) gold mine has 4,000 employees and a monthly output of 1,000 ounces of gold. This mine was also reopened in 1946.
