1 November 1948.

- 1. Vilem Stanovski, Czechoslovakian diplomat, bearer of passport No. 549/48, issued at Prague, 12 October 1948, arrived in Rome, at the Ciampino Airport, on 29 October. He came from Athens and took lodgings at the legation, in Rome.

3 November 1948.

- 2. The transfer of Secretary Ivan Gavora, Press Attache of the Czechoslovakian Legation, in Rome, to Holland, has been revoked. It is reported that he probably will remain in Rome.
- 3. The daughter of the well-known engineer, Carlo Spirek, residing at S. Fiora, Grosseto, arrived in Rome, from Prague, on 2 November 1948, to assume service at the Czechoslovakian Legation, as typist. Temporarily, she has taken lodgings in the house of Major Josef Ruprich, at Via di Villa Emiliani 11.

4 November 1948.

- 4. Herman Mlacho, Czechoslovakian Charge d'Affaire, at Ankara, bearer of passport No. 1474, issued at Prague, 20 March 1945, arrived in Rome, on 2 November 1948. He came from Athens, and took lodgings at the Hotel Massimo d'Azeglio.

6 November 1948.

- 5. Vilem Stanovski, Czechoslovakian diplomat, who arrived in Rome on 29 October 1948, left by air for Prague, on 3 November 1948.
- 6. Secretary Jan Bernat; Stefan Bahna, the assistant to the consul; Margita Majarska, an employee; and Bela Knapova, the typist, all of the Czechoslovakian Legation, in Rome, whose recall to Prague, was foreseen for 25 October
