1. The Naval Command which was at Split, in the former Banovina administrative building, has recently been transferred to Tivat (Boka Kotorska). The transfer was probably because of the fact that the Command was too conspicuous and exposed at Split.

2. The hitherto existing Commands of the Northern, Central and Southern Adriatic ("Seja", "Sraja" and "Juja") have been disbanded and replaced by Commands of Sectors. There is a total of four of these new Commands, as follows:

a. Command of Sector 1

Headquarters - Pulj, comprises the coastal area from the frontier of the Free Territory of Trieste to Zadar, and includes all the islands in that zone.

b. Command of Sector 2

Headquarters - Sibenik, comprises the area from Zadar to Split.

c. Command of Sector 3

Headquarters - Split, comprises the coastal area from Split to Dubrovnik.

d. Command of Sector 4

Headquarters - Dubrovnik, comprises the coastal area from Dubrovnik to the Albanian frontier.
