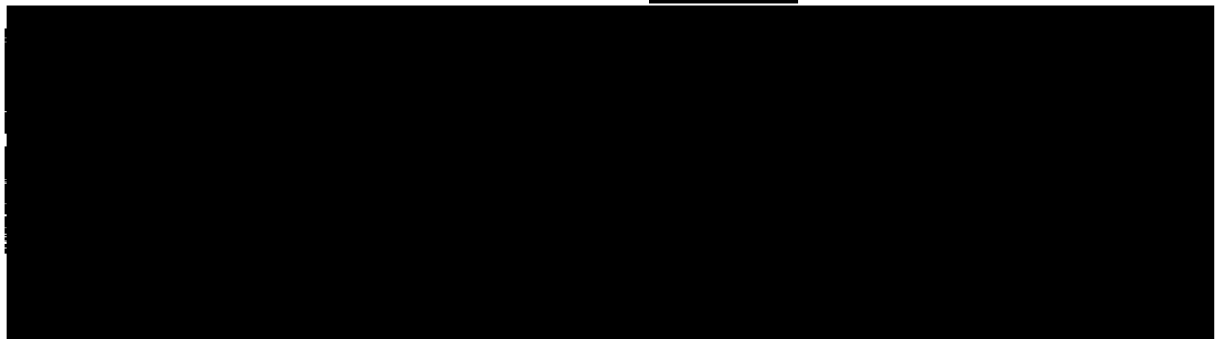

Arcelina Mochel Goto, author of the Communist Q Memento Feminino and a leading Brazilian Communist, applied on 24 November 1948 for a passport, stating that she planned to go to Budapest to attend the Congress of the Women's International Democratic Federation from 1-6 December 1948. She added that after the Congress she intended to proceed to Switzerland for medical treatment. (Source comment. It is likely that she will also transact business for the Communist Party of Brazil while in Switzerland.)
