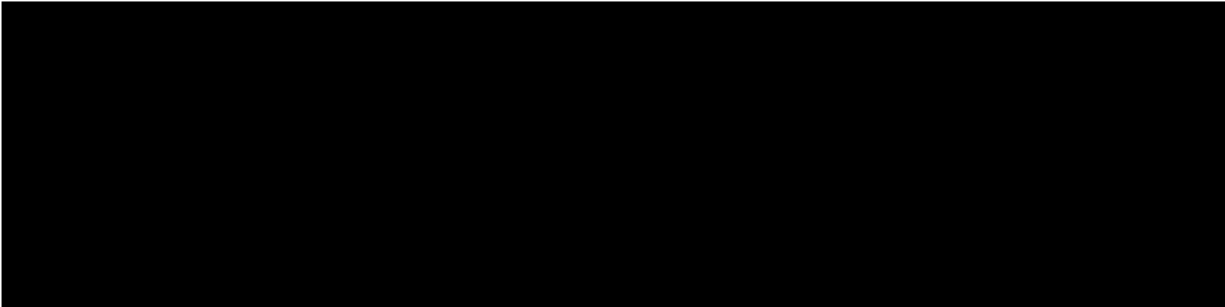

1. The Communists, who have been making little or no progress in their Petroleum Defense Campaign (cf. [redacted]), are believed to be seeking a new issue on which to build their propaganda and prestige and with which to enlist the support of well-known non-Communists. At present it appears that their next effort will revolve around the issue of "defense of world peace."
2. A few women's committees for world peace have already been started in various parts of Brazil under Communist leaders. These seem to use as their foundation numerous "unioes femininas" (women's unions) which were initiated at the behest of the Women's International Democratic Federation (WIDF), and which are backing Brazilian participation in the WIDF Congress in Budapest (cf. [redacted]).
