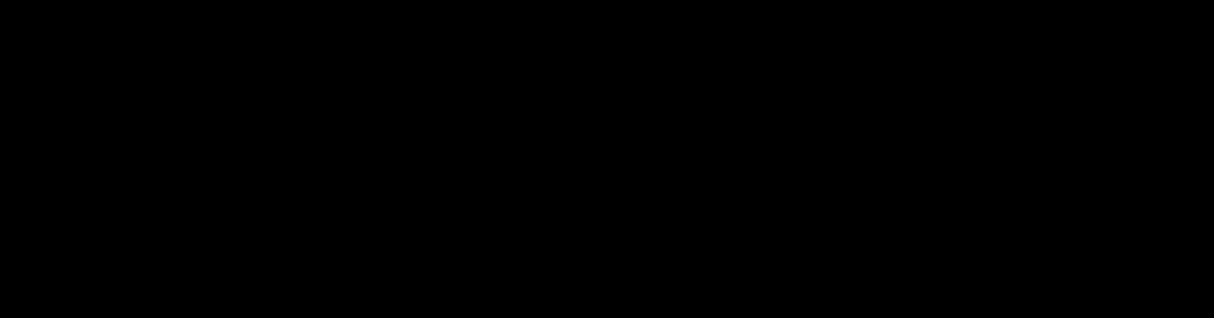

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. The order suspending the publication of Barricada, the weekly organ of the University of San Agustin at Oruro, was made at the instigation of the Minister of Government, Alfredo Mollinedo. Mollinedo had received reports that Barricada was obtaining and utilizing propaganda material from the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City. The Minister made inquiries of the University Council, which issued orders suspending publication of the paper.
2. This suspension caused National Deputies Hernan Quiroga and Felipe Iniguez Medrano, both of whom are members of the Partido Izquierda Revolucionario, to register protests with the Rector of the University.
