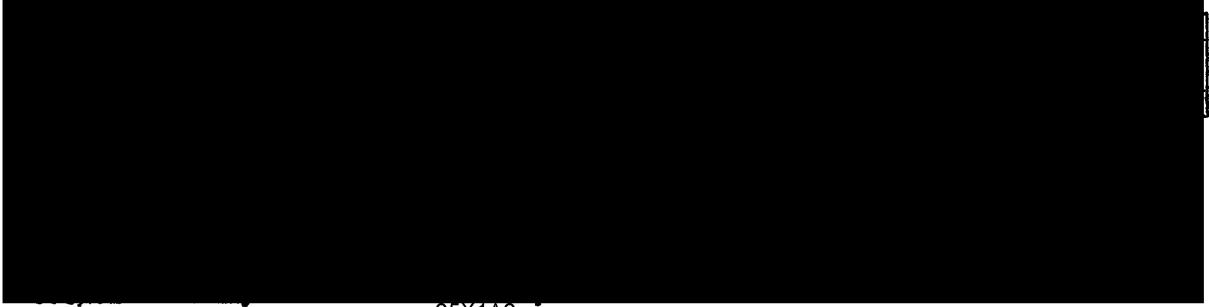

Comment. [REDACTED] reported that R.M. Soeripno came from Prague to Java accompanied by Moeso, his secretary. Moeso used a false Indonesian passport bearing the name Soeparto. Soeripno and Moeso travelled by air from Prague to Jogjakarta via the Hague, Paris, Cairo, New Delhi, Bangkok and Boekit Tinggi.)

- 1. Soeripno and Soeparto arrived in Rangoon from Calcutta by Indian National Airways on 8 July 1948. Their passport particulars were as follows:

Soeripno	Special Envoy and Minister	Indonesian Certificate 7/47 issued at Jogjakarta on 28 June 1947
R. Soeparto	Government Official	Indonesian Certificate 1/48 issued at Prague on 1 April 1948. Visa for Burma issued at Karachi on 21 June 1948

- 2. On 19 July, both passengers left for Bangkok, but returned on 26 July, having apparently failed to secure an onward passage to Indonesia. On 30 July, they left for Singora on an Eastern Airlines (Australian) plane. This plane is to be purchased by the Indonesian Government. While in Rangoon, they stayed with Marjoenani, the Indonesian Representative. On their return from Bangkok to Rangoon, they were accompanied by Sait Noor, an Indonesian official returning from America. Sait Noor was still in Rangoon on 3 September.
- 3. The Dutch Consul (acting Consul General), J.B. Haverkorn van Fijsewijk, when consulted concerning Soeripno and Soeparto, stated that Moeso was travelling as Soeripno's secretary to Boekit Tinggi via Bangkok and Singora.
