SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. The following Soviet and Satellite travelers have recently arrived in or departed from Belgium:

- a. Augustyn Wojnowski, born at Istanbul on 28 August 1910, a government official, arrived in Belgium from Copenhagen on 9 November, carrying Polish passport No. 3282/2109, with Belgian service visa No. 842 issued at Warsaw on 6 November 1948 and valid until 25 November.
- b. Jan Sobolewski, an engineer living in Moscice, left Belgium for Prague on 10 November, carrying Polish service passport No. 3635, with Belgian visa No. 23.649 issued at Brussels on 5 November 1948 and valid for fifteen days. Sobolewski was born at Lwow on 16 August 1901.
- c. Stelian Nitulescu, the new Rumanian Minister to Belgium, has arrived in Brussels. He is a lawyer and recently served as deputy of the "National Grand Assembly". In September 1948 he was in Rome, attending the "Congres de l'Union".
- d. Madame Rodica Barbu, now Second Secretary at the Rumanian Legation in Brussels, has also arrived. She was born on 19 December 1920 in Bucharest.
- e. Serge Krylov, a Soviet born in Leningrad on 1 January 1888 and a resident of Moscow, arrived in Brussels on 1 November 1948. He left for The Hague on 2 November. Subject carried Soviet passport No. 17746 and gave his profession as judge.
- f. On 21 November Vassili Goguina and his wife, Kapitalina Goguina, arrived in Brussels from Prague on business connected with the Soviet Embassy. They are residents of Moscow. Subject carried Soviet service passport No. 34275.

2. The following Polish nationals have applied for military permits:

- a. Maria Kostrzebska Kosowska, born at Elzbietow, Poland on 21 October 1916, employee at the Polish Legation in Brussels, living at 127 rue Froissart, is to go to Warsaw via Prague for a six-week visit. She carries Polish passport No. Z-2631 issued by the Polish Foreign Office on 16 April 1948.
- b. Eliza Szolagowska, born 31 December 1910, living at 174 Avenue Brugmann, Brussels, carries Polish passport No. W-586 issued at Warsaw on 23 January 1946 (or 1948).
- c. Kazimierz Szolagowski, Polish Consul in Belgium, living at 174 Avenue Brugmann, born in Szesutow on 30 June 1885, carries Polish passport No. W-639 issued at Warsaw on 8 February 1946 (or 1948).
- d. Zygmunt Zygan, born at Radom on 23 November 1901, living at 25 rue des Francs, Brussels, is going to Warsaw via Prague. He is a delegate of the Polish steel industry and carries passport No. 3142 issued by the Polish Foreign Office on 15 November 1947.
