1. A thorough check of information contained in [REDACTED] by reliable and extremely well-placed sources on the spot has shown that
  - a. leading People's Party members have no knowledge of the meeting reported to have taken place on 26 October 1948;
  - b. it would have been impossible for the PP to present a plan, since it has not yet decided what type army it desires;
  - c. last spring, Minister Oskar Helmer drafted a plan for the organization of a secret armed gendarmerie, but the plan had not met with the approval of leading PP circles and had been abandoned;
  - d. informed PP circles disclaim any knowledge of an agreement on a 2,000 - man volunteer corps and state that negotiations with the Socialists are still in the primary stage.
