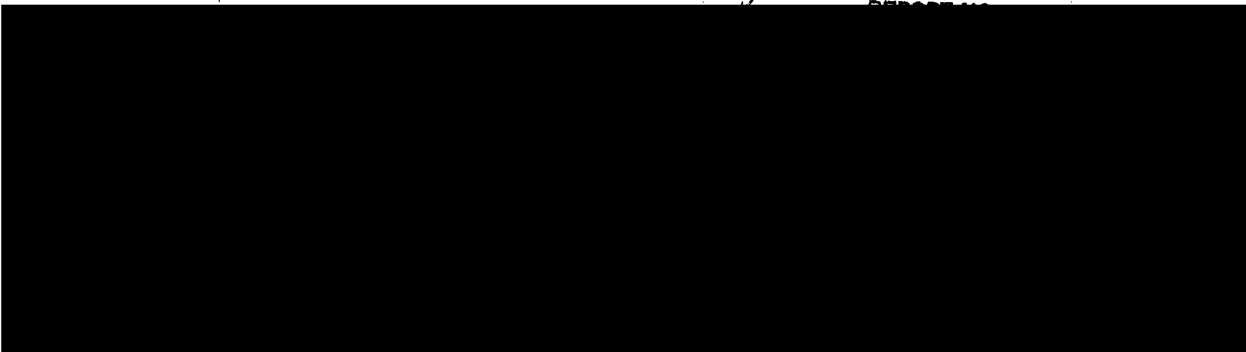

Comment. President Natalicio Gonzalez of Paraguay has revealed that insurgents from Uruguay to Clorinda, Argentina, are preparing to invade Paraguay on or about 1 January 1949. The President's information is said to have been reported to him by a Paraguayan consular official in Clorinda. Gonzalez intends to take every precaution to protect his government.)

According to source, the situation in Asuncion continues to be tense. Felipe Molas Lopez, Liberato Rodriguez, and Major Adalberto Canata are insisting on immediate (Natalicio) Gonzalez-Democratic Colorado unification. A coup d'etat led by Canata is possible, although Canata himself is not sure of full support within the vital cavalry division.
