

During the recent UNESCO conference in Beirut, certain members of Latin American delegations attempted, according to source, to activate a Latin American-Arab bloc which would be directed against the Anglo-American bloc, particularly against the United States. Leader of this movement among the Latin American delegates was Diego Molinari, of Argentina, and other active supporters were Del Rio y Canedo of Mexico, Carneire of Brasil, and the Peruvian delegate. Molinari, Del Rio y Canedo, and Carneire were in contact with Sami Kayyalah of Syria; Pierre Jumayl, the Lebanese Phalange leader; Kamal Jumblatt, Druze leader; and Camille Shamun, opposition leader.
