

- The two radio stations, Radio Amauta and Radio Abaroa, both of La Paz and both anti-Government, are each given a subcidy of 1500 bolivianos a month 25X1A6a by the Partido Izquierda Revolucionario (PIR). Comment. The offices of Radio Amauta have previously been reported as the meeting place of the PIR-controlled Union Progresista de Mujeres. 25X1A6a
- 2. The proprietor of Radio Amauta is Jenaro Saavedra Perez, who delivers political commentaries over the station under the pseudonym, Tupaj Catari. Comment. Saavedra made a violent radio and newspaper attack on Chile and the Chilean Army in October 1943, charging plans for an attack against Bolivia.
