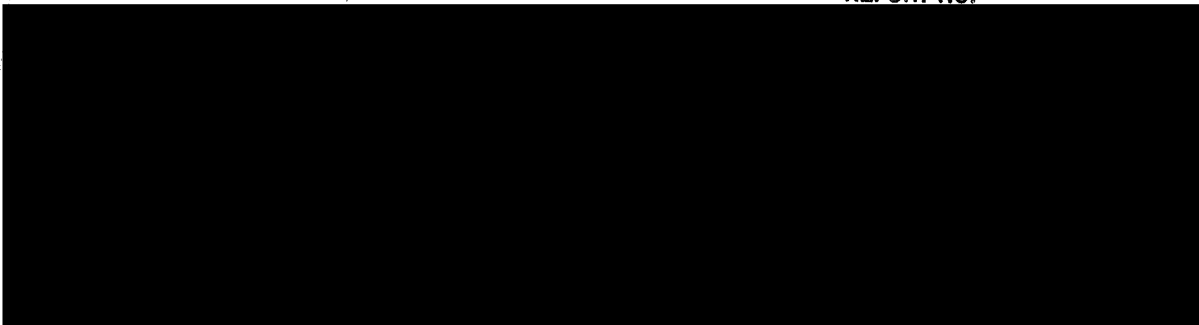

- 1. In Shanghai on 8 February LI Tsung-jen stated that he was extremely discouraged. He feels that nothing can be accomplished with the present cabinet, and that he has been frustrated at every turn by underlings who have refused to carry out his orders because of their allegiance to CHIANG Kai-shek.
- B-3 2. LI indicated that he would ask for SUN Fo's resignation immediately if either CHANG Chun or CHANG Chih-chung, whom he had approached, would accept the premiership. Up to the present both men have refused to consider the post.
- 3. LI also indicated that he is worried over the Chinese Communist threat to Hankow.
