1. Jan Boukal and Josef Beran, Czechoslovak citizens, arrived in Rome on 24 October 1948 and returned to Prague by air on 17 November 1948.
2. Marta Matouckova, wife of the Czechoslovak Minister in Rome, and Milos Pacak, Counsellor of the Czechoslovak Legation, Rome, departed by air for Prague on 1 January 1949.
3. Bohumil Verner, Czechoslovak diplomat, bearer of passport No. 626/68 issued at Prague on 27 December 1948, arrived in Rome from Prague on 2 January 1949. He has been designated as Secretary of the Czechoslovak Legation, Rome.
4. Joseph Uher, Czechoslovak diplomat, bearer of passport No. 266 issued at Prague on 1 September 1947, arrived in Rome on 7 January 1949 and took lodgings at the Hotel Massimo d'Azeglio.
5. Bohumil Novak, Czechoslovak citizen, bearer of service passport No. 16, issued at Prague on 3 January 1949, arrived in Rome on 9 January 1949. On 20 January he departed by air for Athens.
