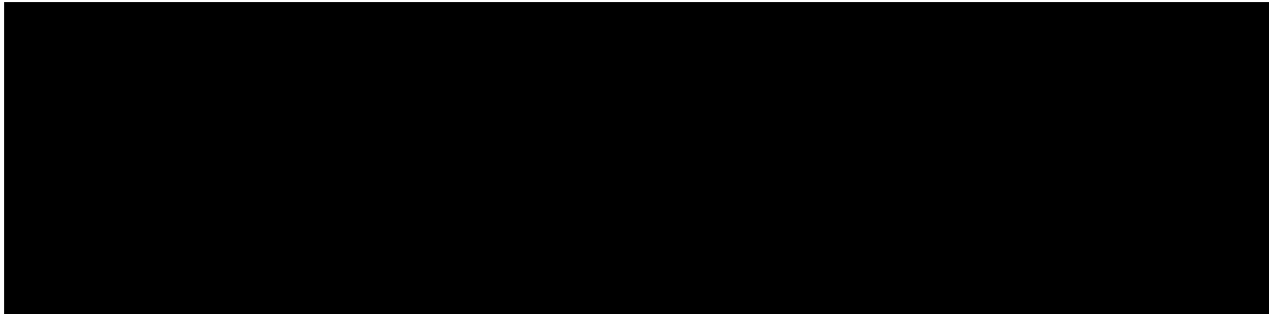

1. The Universidad Obrera de Mexico, the Workers' University of Mexico, is sending Marxist propaganda to Luis Luksic, prominent Partido Izquierda Revolucionario (PIR) leader.
2. A copy of the pamphlet entitled "El Terror Franquista en Espana", printed in Santiago, September 1948, has also arrived from Chile, addressed to the CESTB.\* This pamphlet, sponsored by a group in Chile established for the purpose of aiding Spanish democracy, and called "Agrupacion Chilena de Ayuda a La Democracia Espanola", attacks the Franco regime and lists a large number of Spanish republicans said to have been executed by Franco.
3. Communist propaganda is also reported to be received by a Polish Jew named Samuel Szaidleder, at Avenida Zalles No. 162, in La Paz.
