SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. A meeting of the Executive Board of the Nationalist Party of Chile* was held at the party headquarters, Calle Huerfanos 1164, Santiago, on 27 January 1949. During this meeting, Gaston Alejandro Acuna MacLean stated that the Nationalist Party of Chile should warn nationalist groups throughout Latin America of the danger presented by United States economic pressure. He stated that such pressure is dangerous not only to the economic sovereignty of the various American countries, but also to their political independence. Acuna MacLean maintained that the only effective means of opposing United States capitalist imperialism was by close co-operation between the nationalist groups in the Latin American countries.
2. Before the meeting adjourned, it was agreed that the Nationalist Party of Chile should contact nationalist groups in Argentina, Peru, Bolivia, Venezuela, and other countries to advocate the formation of an effective anti-United States bloc throughout Latin America.
