The outlet for Siamese antimony, wolfram, and other non-ferrous metals is a Chinese exporter named "Chang", who arrived in Siam four and a half months ago from Singapore. In Singapore, "Chang" served as the "front" for shipments of rubber to Soviet interests. It is believed that he forwarded the rubber, as he probably now does the Siamese products, to Hong Kong or Shanghai, where they were transhipped to other ports, probably including Vladivostok.
