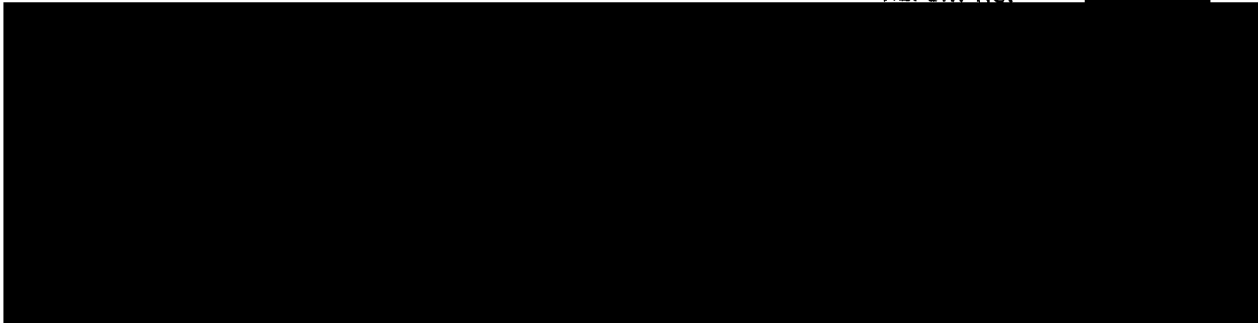

1. In the last few weeks there has been a noticeable increase of Soviet troop transports on the Hungarian railways, particularly in the direction of the Yugoslav border.
2. The Soviets have enlarged the building of the non-commissioned officers' school in Jutass (Veszprem) and established an instruction school for Russian non-commissioned officers there.
3. The military camp in Jutass has been changed into a tank depot. Approximately 200 tanks are stationed in the new hangars. These tanks are larger than the tanks used by the Red Army when they came into Hungary in 1945 and larger than any of the German Tiger tanks.
