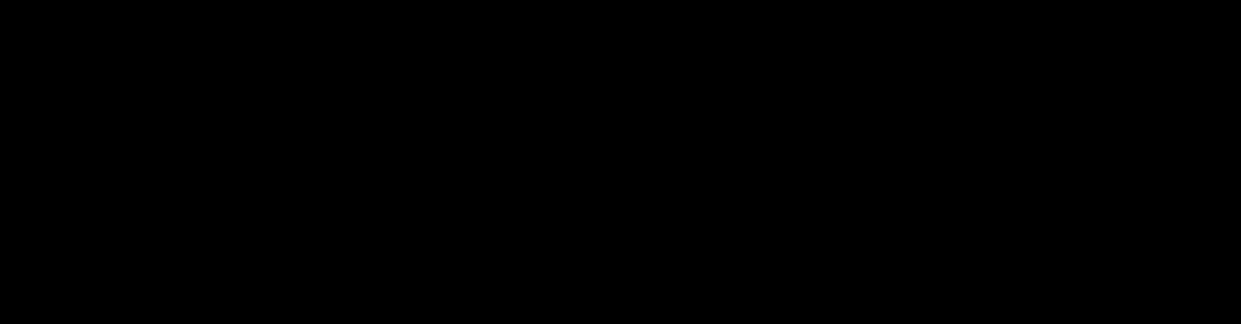

1. Bulgarian-Albanian guerrilla concentrations, in groups of 1,500 men each, are located in the Upper Struma Valley under the direction of the Bulgarian Commander of the First Army, General Tochev.

2. Tank movements are taking place in a southward direction in the Dobruja area. [REDACTED] however, whether the [REDACTED] of a Soviet unit being moved to the south or whether the equipment was being turned over to the Bulgarian Army which is known to be in need of armored equipment.

3. The Bulgarian intentions, [REDACTED], are to:

- a. Augment the pressure on Yugoslavia
- b. Reestablish direct overland contact with Albania
- c. Realize a unified Macedonia dependent upon Bulgaria, with the capital at Salonika.
