1. Peruvian Minister of Development and Public Works Alfonso Llosa has made the following statements on the source of Police Director Moises Mier y Teran's support within the Military Junta. Llosa indicated that both Mier y Teran and Ernesto Cabada Dancourt, the Director of Government, were appointed as the direct result of great pressure exercised by Senator Ignacio Brandariz. Brandariz has been previously reported as one of Odria's increasingly influential advisors.*
2. Mier y Teran held office under former President Prado, and source stated that Brandariz, then an advisor of Prado, was one of the main stumbling blocks to Mier y Teran's removal from office. Source characterized Mier y Teran as a criminal who will stop at nothing to achieve his ends, but agreed with previous reports which state that he is not specifically anti-American.
