SUPPLEMENT

1. The National Council of the Nationalist Party of Chile met on 1 April 1949 at Calle Coquimbo 1262, Santiago, Chile. Hedilberto Bizama Merino presided over the meeting which was attended by fifteen national councilmen.
2. The most important discussion centered on a letter received from Luis S. Getica, chief of the Valparaiso Nationalist Party organization in which Bizama Merino was censured for not having supported the Hispano-American Nationalist Movement and for not having taken a more active role in the recent congressional elections.
3. Bizama Merino considered these accusations to be exceedingly grave, and claimed them to be the result of the recent activities of Luis Callis and Edgido Bachi. These two persons are members of the revolutionary Nationalist group known as "Ultra" which believes in close collaboration with Argentine Nationalist Emilio Gutierrez Herrero in the formation of a coordinated Latin American Nationalist movement. Orlando Espinoza and Julio Vallejos Urbina were chosen to investigate this matter and to report the result of their findings at the next executive meeting.
