- Jerzy Grudzinski, the new Polish Consul General to Sao Paulo, passed through Rio de Janeiro on 6 April aboard the SS KILINSKI en route to Buenos Aires. He was in charge of a bag and box of diplomatic mail destined for the Polish Legation in Argentina. Grudzinski planned to return to Brazil aboard the KILIUSKI on 28 April.
- 2. While in Buenos Aires, Grudzinski contacted Martin Raduj, a wel -known Polish Communist. Apparently Grduzinski brought a large amount of wodka, tobacco, and other merchandise which he wanted to smuggle into Argentina and sell. This alarmed Raduj because Polish ships are being closely watched by the Argentine police and Grudzinski's scheme might have caused an embarrassing incident.
- 3. When Grudzinski arrives in Sao Paulo, Franciszak Winnicki, the Polish Consul there, will be appointed Commercial Attache to the Legation in Rio, but he will be detailed to Sao Paulo.
- Grudzinskî, who was accompanied by his wife, mother, and two daughters, is described as 39 years old, six feet tall, fair-haired, slightly bald, redfaced, and talkative. He is believed to have attended a university in Switzerland, to be proficient in German, and to have a slight knowledge of French. His wife is a brunette, approximately 5° 5" tall, weighs about 125 pounds, and is a quiet type.
