1. At the end of March 1949, a new Soviet office was opened in Berlin-Friedrichsfelde at Schlossstrasse 32C. Called the "USSR SMAD Office for the Protection of Patents and the Purchase of Inventions" (USSdR SMAD Verwaltung für Patentschutz und Ankauf von Erfindungen), this bureau occupies a former private dwelling which has been refurbished.
2. The major work of the office appears to consist of translating details and descriptions of inventions. Source adds that competent translators can always find work there.
3. Chief of the office is (nu) Trifanov.
