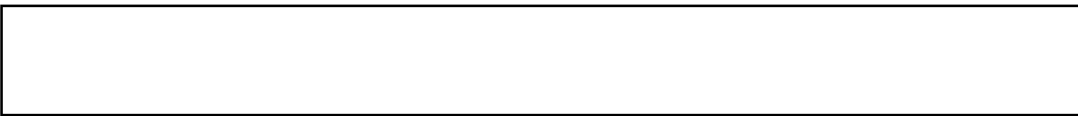

Voz Proletaria, a Trotskyite newspaper which has been published clandestinely monthly or bimonthly for the past 18 months, is owned and edited by Eduardo Gonzalez.* It is printed by Editorial La Argentina, located at Calle Alem 172. This newspaper, with a circulation of approximately 3000, is of little or no importance. The Trotskyite movement in Argentina has been leaning more and more toward Stalin.
2. Gonzalez, an Argentine national, is well known in Communist circles and is listed by the Federal Police as a Trotskyite. He is believed to be a journalist who spent some years in Spain but was forced to flee from Madrid because of his anti-Franco activities. Although he invariably gives his address as Calle Pampa 1835, Buenos Aires, this address does not exist. Approximately one year ago Gonzalez traveled to Chile. He makes frequent trips to Montevideo where he apparently circulates in anarchist circles.
3. Accion Liberataria, also published clandestinely, is a more inflammatory newspaper but has a much smaller circulation than Voz Proletaria. It is headed by Jaime Caceres, apparently a Chilean, who is known to the Argentine and Chilean police. Caceres and Gonzalez aid each other in their activities.
