1. Bolivian Movimiento Nacionalista Revolucionario (MNR) exiles in Argentina still believe that through the labor disturbances being fomented by the MNR, they will succeed in causing the Bolivian government to resign.
2. Carlos Montenegro, MNR leader in Buenos Aires, is in frequent telephone communication with Juan Lechin and others expelled to Chile. Neither Montenegro nor Paz Estenssoro shows any signs of preparing to leave Buenos Aires. Montenegro is said to be upset over the killing of foreigners, but otherwise appears satisfied with the progress of events.
