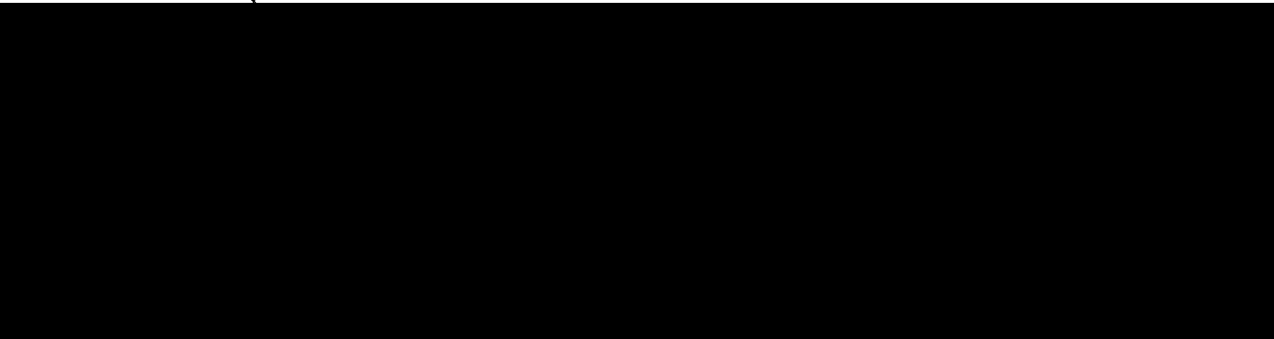

1. During 1 and 9 April 1949, the following eastbound transports, bound for Brest-Litovsk, passed through Frankfurt/Oder:

2. During the same period, 389 empty cars passed through Frankfurt/Oder on their way to Brest-Litovsk. In addition, two trains of 111 cars with troops and vehicles from Cottbus, bound for Küstrin-Kietz, passed through Frankfurt/Oder.
