1. The following trains with Soviet materiel were observed in the KUESTRIN (O 53/V 66) area between 28 May and 11 June 1949:

a. 28 May 1949: A train of 40 cars with 36 trucks and lumber going towards Poland. All trucks [REDACTED] 25X1B

b. 2 June 1949: A train of 30 boxcars occupied by soldiers and 24 cars loaded with trucks with mounted rocket launchers, proceeding towards BERLIN. On arrival in WERBIG (O 53/V56), the train was diverted to EBERSWALDE (N 53/V 08).

c. 11 June 1949:

(1) A freight train with 50 trucks proceeding to EBERSWALDE at about 2:30 a.m.

(2) A freight train with about a hundred guns with short, thick barrels and two trucks, coming from FRANKFURT/Oder passing through WERBIG at about 3:15 a.m., going towards WRIEZEN (N 53/V 37).

(3) An east-bound freight train of 38 cars with ammunition.

25X1A 2. [REDACTED] Comment:

a. The train observed on 28 May 1949 presumably carried MVD motor vehicles [REDACTED] from the FREIBERG and AUE areas to the Soviet Union. (See two previous reports, according to which 45 motor vehicles were shipped from AUE to BREST on 25 May 1949.) 25X1B

b. The trains observed on 2 and 11 June 1949 either carried supply materiel or transferred troops and materiel to a troop training grounds in the EBERSWALDE area.
