SOURCE	were made in GYOLA (P 48/X 44):

1. difle (Vadasz) Barracks:

Occupied by a guard detail of about 30 men wearing redbordered black epaulets with artillery insignia. The trucks observed in the barracks area were still blocked up as was observed before. The stocks of fire wood had been increased.

25X1B

The track was repeatedly seen in the barracks area and in the town.

2. Artillery Barracks, JYOUR-SZABADMEGY:

To activity was observed in the barracks. One soldier wearing red-bordered black epaulets was seen.

3. Frigyes Barracks:

Intensive construction work was done on all barracks buildings, presumably for hungarian purposes.

4. Several neglected houses at 10 Crazag Street:

some sick boviet soldiers with red-bordered black epaulets. Four or five tracks and some horse-drawn vehicles were also seen there.

5. Ho changes were observed with the Hig of the Mungarian 5th Border Guard En on Apaca Street.

The report indicates that the situation in GYOLR in early September 1949 was as previously observed (rear details; blocked-up motor vehicles). The reported motor vehicle number belongs to the 17th ids mecz Div.
