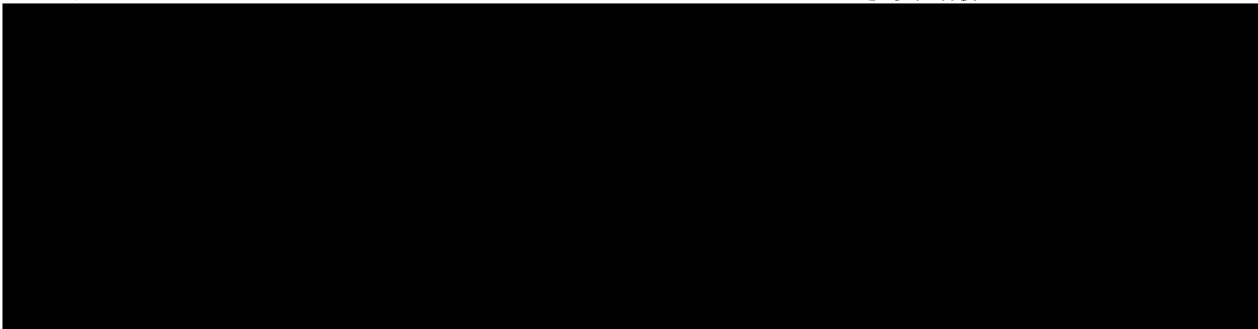

Communist Party of Chile (PCCh), the Party has abandoned the idea of having each militant register the addresses of intimate friends who would be willing to receive mail for the militants.* The PCCh feared that the police might discover the master list of cover addresses and make mass arrests of Party members and sympathizers. [REDACTED] each cell leader has been instructed to locate in his respective sector a non-Party member willing to accept and hide, in an emergency, any Party books, pamphlets, or similar material.
2. The majority of the Party members have been warned to abstain from writing letters and to deliver personally all letters, books, and publications. However, the Party leaders are using the following three addresses for purposes of general communications:

Comment: It was previously reported [REDACTED] that all militant members of the Party should register addresses to serve as illegal or cover addresses throughout the country. These addresses should be those of friends who were not members of the PCCh. The addresses of obscure or unknown Communist militants were also to be used, but the correspondence sent to them was to be addressed to their mothers or sisters.
