During the first few days of October 1949, a whispering campaign was initiated by the Yugoslav Ministry of Propaganda and spread throughout Serbia only. The rumor was to the effect that General Draza Mihailovic was still alive and living in full comfort in a fortress to which all access is forbidden. Furthermore, it was stated that Marshal Tito occasionally visits Mihailovic.
