

- The air-raid siren towers on the outskirts of Bucharest are constructed of four to six inch timbers. These structures are approximately fifteen feet square at the base and eight feet square at the top, varying in height from thirty to forty-five feet. A black crudely-built box, eighteen inches by eighteen inches by four feet, apparently empty, is placed at the top of each tower. A rung type ladder leads to a lower platform approximately fifteen feet above the ground. A smaller ladder leads to the platform where the box is placed. On the ground at the base of each structure, apparently in the geometric center, a concrete block resembling a surveyor's benchmark has been placed.
  - These towers are apparently scattered at random around the outskirts of Eucharest. Those examined were approximately one kilometer apart.
