1. a. The Albrecht Kaserne, KORNEUBURG (P 49/S 30), was occupied by about 300 troops. Recruits were observed being drilled.
- b. Twenty soldiers at the most were quartered in the Franz Josef Kaserne.
- c. All observed troops wore red-bordered, black epaulets.
2. a. The STOCKERAU (O 49/S 21) Prinz Eugen Kaserne was occupied by about 300 troops and the Jaeger Kaserne by about 200 troops. Recruits were observed being drilled at both kasernen.
- b. The Reiter Kaserne was still occupied by a supply unit of about 30 men with horse-drawn vehicles.
- c. All observed troops wore red-bordered, black epaulets.
3. No motor vehicles were observed in KORNEUBURG and STOCKERAU.

Comment:

The report shows that the KORNEUBURG and STOCKERAU kasernen of AAA units (23rd AAA Div?) were still almost vacant in mid-October 1949. It can be inferred that the units were still on maneuvers (in APETLON?).
