1. Chilean Investigaciones are trying to trace a gun which was used in the shooting affray on 7 November 1949 and which wounded two detectives during the wake of Ricardo Fonseca Aguayo in July. Investigaciones believe that the weapon belongs to a member of the Communist Brigada de Orden, and they feel that if they can locate it, they may be able to obtain more information on the composition and functions of the Brigada.
2. A ballistic report furnished to Luis Brun D'Avoglio indicated that some of the bullets fired during the demonstration on 7 November came from the same gun which wounded the detectives in July.
