

- New sources of uranium have been discovered near Cinvald (Zinnwald N51/F25), in the neighborhood of Janske Lazne (Johannisbad - 051/G65), and near Male Svatonovice (051/G24). Mining of these deposits is supposed to begin in the near future.
- 2. A plant for the refining and classification of ore has been constructed at Horni Slavkov near Karlovy Vary (Karlsbad - N57/P69), where uranium mines have recently been opened.
- 3. The following is a list of some of the Russian personnel employed at the Jachymov (N51/K60) mines:
 - a. Razev (fnu). About 50 years old, he is second in command of the Jachymov mines and the representative of the General Director.
 - b. Kolicev (fnu). Arproximately 42 years old, he is the Director of the Technical Control Department located in the former tobacco factory in Jachymov.
 - c. Userov (fnu). About 50 years old, he is chief of the Processing Plant at the Elias Mine.
 - d. Posikova (fnu). About 35 years old, she is the Chief of the Collecting Section. Her function is to make tests for ore anywhere in Czechoslovakia.

These people are the most outstanding figures at Jachymov and receive a monthly bonus of 60,000 Kcs in addition to their regular salaries.

4. Ore in powdered form is put into barrels weighing about 50 kg, which are then wolded shut. Labels designating the group of miners who mined the ore are then put on the barrels.
