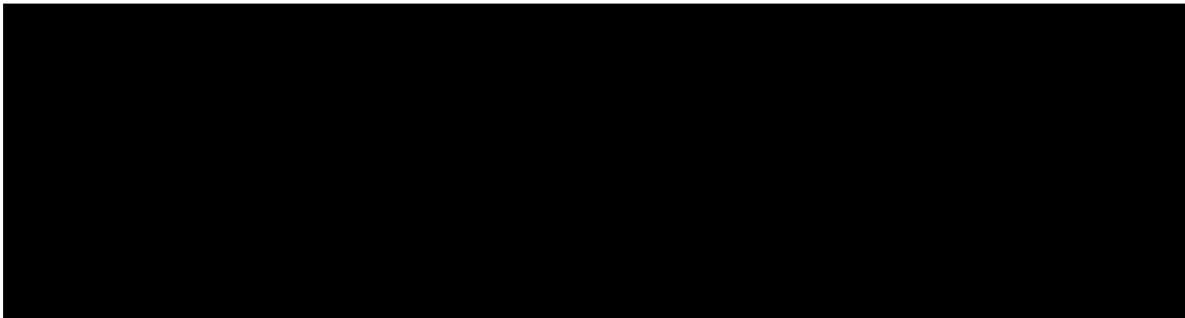

[redacted] the Chilean Ambassador to Argentina, German Vergara Donoso told Frano Cvjetisa, former Yugoslav Minister to Brazil, that Chile was considering renewing diplomatic relations with Yugoslavia. The Chilean Ambassador stated that he did not, however, expect a decision by his government in the near future. Vergara Donoso felt that Chile's desire to align itself with Tito in his fight against Moscow might constitute an argument in favor of renewed relations.

2. Cvjetisa believes that it is Chile's desire that Yugoslav Minister to Argentina Franc Pirc's replacement be persona grata to the Chilean government in the event that the new Yugoslav Minister to Argentina is also accredited to Chile. It would then be much easier for Chile to renew relations with Yugoslavia. Chile does not want a Yugoslav representative who might exert a harmful influence on the numerous wealthy Yugoslav residents of Chile.
