- 25X1X 1. [REDACTED] an airfield of 12 square kilometers was east of PRAUST (Q 55/Y 41), north of the PRAUST-MOENCHENREBIN (Q 55/Y 51) road, in line with ROSTAU (Q 55/Y 41).
2. The N-S and W-E runway, each 66 feet wide, were concreted. There were no hangars, but intensive construction work was under way. A concrete parking site was on the field section toward the road.
