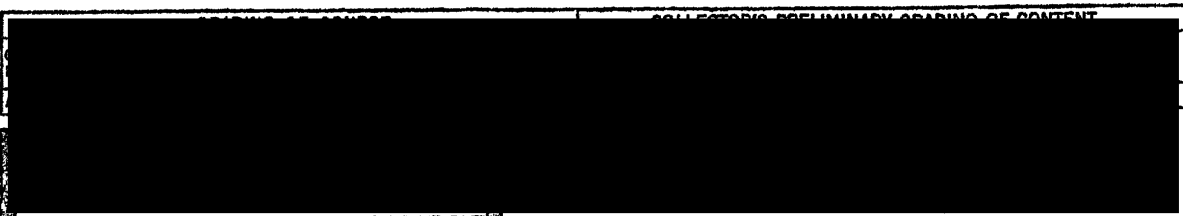

1. During the past few months, two issues of a mimeographed, clandestine, Communist newspaper called El Opositor have appeared in Santiago. This newspaper, which is not an official Communist Party publication, is published by a group of Communist university students and contains jokes, insults, and poems against the present government and especially against such so-called "brain trusters" as Dario Poblete Nunez, Osvaldo Fagundes Olivares, Luis Brun d'Avoglio, and Luis Hernandez Parker. Hernandez Parker, the former Secretary General of the Chilean Communist Youth, was long ago expelled from the Communist Party and is now a radio and newspaper political commentator.
2. Both issues of El Opositor were of approximately 300 copies and were mailed to congressmen and other members of the government. No issues have appeared lately as the university students are on summer vacation.
3. The second issue of El Opositor claimed that the government had organized the 7 November 1949 shooting affray in the Plaza de Armas of Santiago, which is commonly considered to have been Communist-led.
