1. Anton Erman, a special emissary and inspector of the Yugoslav Foreign Office, recently arrived in Buenos Aires for the purpose of briefing Yugoslav Legation personnel on their public statements regarding the recent resignation of Frane Pirc as Minister of the Legation. Erman was expected to insist that Pirc's resignation be given no publicity among Yugoslav immigrants. The Legation has been instructed to suggest to the Slav community that Pirc will probably return to Yugoslavia during March 1950. 25X1

3. Marijan Stilinovic, the new Yugoslav Minister to Argentina, will attempt to win over pro-Cominform Yugoslav immigrants in Argentina, Chile, and Uruguay by means of pro-Fito propaganda. A second major task of the new Minister will be an endeavor to renew diplomatic relations between Chile and Yugoslavia.
