1. The State Commission for Economic Planning (Panstwowa Komisja Planowania Gospodarczego - FKPG) was created as a result of the decree of February 1949 which provided for the reorganization of the Supreme Economic Authorities of Poland. Its functions consist of:
 - a. Direction of the over-all policy of state economic planning.
 - b. Coordination of the economic activities of all governmental administrative departments.
 - c. Coordination of financial planning.
 - d. Direction of technical planning within the national economy.
 - e. Study of ways and means of increasing economic cooperation with the USSR and other People's Democracies.
 - f. Study of and views on suggestions submitted to the Economic Committee of the Council of Ministers (KZPM).
 - g. Direction of the activities of the Voievodship Offices for Economic Planning.
 - h. Study of questions concerning national economy either on their own initiative, or on instructions from the Council of Ministers or from the Economic Committee of the Council of Ministers.
 - i. Handling of all business with which the Central Planning Office and the Ministry of Industry and Trade were concerned up to 30 April 1949, in such business had not already been, or was not to be, transferred to another ministry or department.

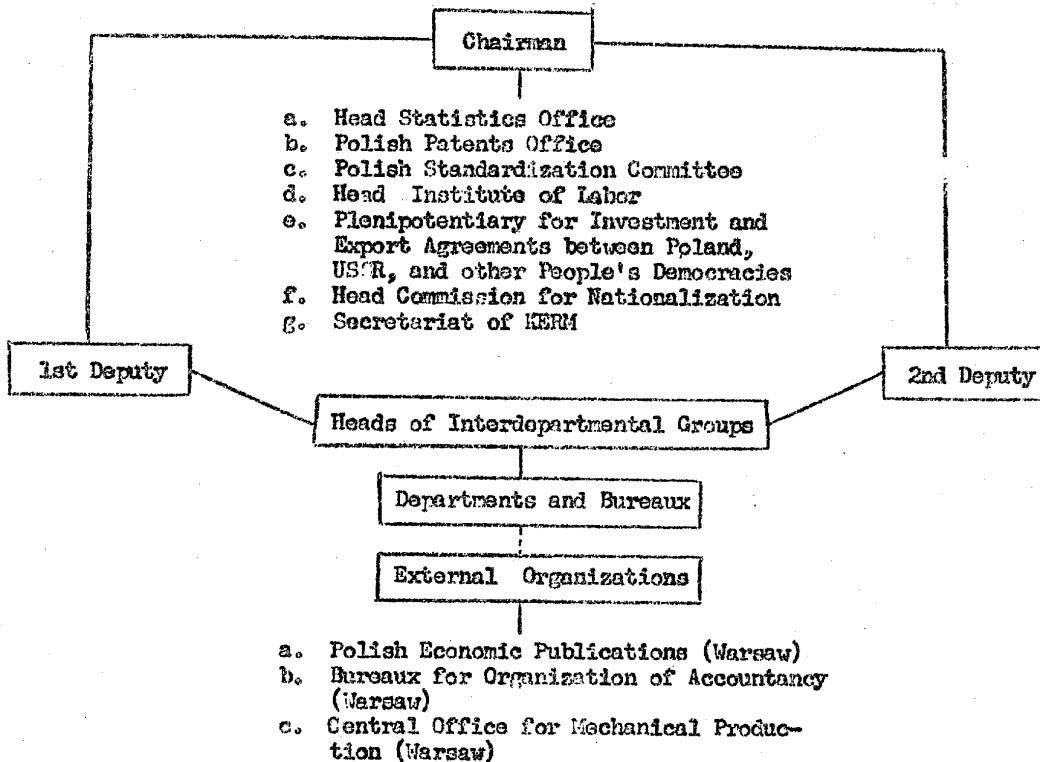

2. Structure of the PKPG3. Board of the PKPG

a. The Board of the PKPG consists of the following members:

- 1) Chairman
- 2) Two Deputy Chairmen
- 3) Heads of Interdepartmental Groups
- 4) Heads of the Chairman's and Deputy Chairmen's Private Offices
- 5) Chief of Personnel Section
- 6) Chief of Economic Information Section
- 7) Chief of Special Section

b. The Chairman of the PKPG has subordinated to him, in addition to these departments which are part of the PKPG, the various divisions shown in paragraph 2. These divisions are not components of the PKPG. Their work is coordinated with that of the PKPG only because of the unique position of the Chairman. The divisions concerned are the following:

- 1) Head Statistics Office (Główny Urząd Statystyczny)
- 2) Polish Patents Office (Urząd Patentowy P.P.)
- 3) Polish Standardization Committee (Polski Komitet Normalizacyjny)
- 4) Head Institute of Labor (Główny Instytut Pracy)
- 5) Plenipotentiary for Investment and Export Agreements between Poland, USSR, and other People's Democracies (Polnomocnik do spraw umow inwestycyjnych i dostaw między Rzadem P.P. a Rządami ZSSR i Krajów demokracji lud.)
- 6) Head Commission for Nationalization of Private Enterprises

- c. All the Secretariats of these bureaux and departments have identical structure, and their counterparts are situated in the private offices of the Chairman and Deputy Chairmen in the PKPG. The Secretariats have the following functions:
- 1) They draw up plans of work for a given department and prepare general reports on the results achieved.
 - 2) They deal with the personnel problems of the department.
 - 3) They deal with the budgeting for the department.
 - 4) They handle the publication of Instructions and the collection of official publications.
 - 5) They carry out general office duties.
