1. The following officers of the Soviet Zone German police left for the Soviet Union on 1 December 1949 to attend a training course:
  - a. RIEDEL, regular police lieutenant colonel from HALLB (M 53/D 92).
  - b. WOLF, regular police first lieutenant from the county police headquarters of BITTERFELD (M 52/E 15).
  - c. DEUTSCHMANN, regular police first lieutenant from the county police headquarters of DELITZSCH (N 52/L 13).
2. The mentioned officers, who are considered to be "faithful to the party line," were picked up at their offices by MVD guards and taken to a train bound for the Soviet Union. They were not allowed to send word to their families before leaving.
